

Kyoto University Orientation for New Students of the Second semester in 2020



In order to help students make a smooth start to their new academic and research life at Kyoto University, all university-wide organisations involved in the Information Environment, Library and Environmental Safety and Health are collaborating to provide guidance to newly enrolled students. The University-wide guidance for students entering in the second semester of the 2020 academic year, which will be held in October this year, will not be carried out face to face as in previous years to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus, but will instead be carried out by video streaming using the Kyoto University Learning Support System (Panda). It is strongly recommended that you log in to Panda from your own computer for infection control purposes. However, if you are preparing for a PC/network environment, or if you are having trouble with your PC/network, a video of the guidance will be broadcast on the 3rd floor of the Institute for Liberal Arts and Sciences building.
